Every two minutes, a woman in the U.S. is diagnosed with breast cancer. It remains the most common cancer in women worldwide, and inevitably, we all know someone who has been affected by this insidious disease.

For us, breast cancer hit home when our sister Betsy was diagnosed with triple-negative breast cancer. Vowing to fight back, we founded Pink Promises to benefit the Breast Cancer Research Foundation (BCRF), the largest private funder of breast cancer research worldwide. Over the past seven years, the compassionate and generous community of Long Island has raised over \$4 million for Pink Promises, which translates to funding 16 research grants for the world's most innovative and groundbreaking investigators.

BCRF was founded by Evelyn H. Lauder in 1993; since that time, breast cancer survival rates have improved by 38% and there are nearly three million survivors in the U.S. today. Never has a cancer-free horizon been more in reach than with BCRF's global brain trust of researchers at the helm. BCRF-funded investigators have been involved in every major breakthrough in breast cancer prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and survivorship. However, more work is needed to understand how breast cancer cells spread to other organs, and to develop new treatments for cancers that do not currently respond to existing therapies.
